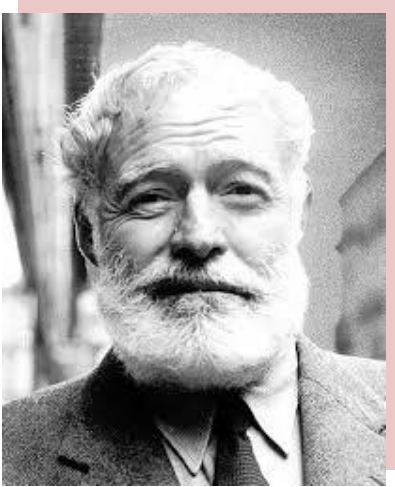


# Author of the Week

## ERNEST HEMINGWAY



Ernest Hemingway was a Nobel Prize-winning American writer who touched the pinnacles of fame with his novel 'The Old Man and the Sea' which catapulted him to international glory. Over the course of his writing career, he published seven novels, six short story collections, and two non-fiction works which greatly influenced later generations of writers. A highly acclaimed writer, most of his works are considered classics of American literature.

### Life and career

*"There is no friend as loyal as a book."* **Ernest Hemingway**

- Ernest Miller Hemingway was born in Edmonds, Washington, to a physician, and his mother, Grace Hall-Hemingway, was a musician. Both his parents were greatly respected in their conservative community.
- His novel 'A Farewell to Arms', set during the Italian campaign of World War I, is considered to be one of his first major critically acclaimed successes. The book, which revolves around a love affair between the expatriate American Henry and Catherine Barkley against the backdrop of World War I, became his first best-seller.
- 'For Whom the Bell Tolls' is another one of his best-known works. The novel tells the story of a young American who is attached to a republican guerrilla unit during the Spanish Civil War. Death is a primary theme of the novel.
- His novel, 'The Old Man and the Sea' was the last major work of fiction to be produced by Hemingway and published in his lifetime. It is also one of his most famous works. The story revolves around an aging fisherman who manages to catch a huge fish but is unable to enjoy his success as his catch is eaten up by the sharks.





